

## Other Ways to Support LA Wildfire Disaster Relief Efforts

### Financial Aid & Basic Needs:

**California Fire Foundation**: Distributes immediate \$250 emergency assistance cards to families who lost their homes.

**Gobble Gobble Give**: Delivers hot meals, shelter, and essential supplies to homeless individuals impacted by fires.

**Los Angeles Regional Food Bank**: Supplies emergency meals and groceries to families displaced by fires.

**National Day Laborer Organizing Network**: Supporting immigrant workers impacted by the LA fires.

**The Partnership for Inclusive Disaster Strategies**: Has a hotline for disabled people seeking help evacuating or getting care. **The Sidewalk Project**: Supporting the unhoused population in LA.

**United Way of Ventura County**: Provides direct financial relief to Palisades Fire victims for emergency expenses.

**World Central Kitchen**: Has mobilized relief teams throughout the Los Angeles area to feed first responders and affected residents.

### Medical & Emergency Response:

**Direct Relief**: Delivers critical medical supplies and funding to LA County healthcare providers serving affected areas.

**LAFD Foundation**: Supplies firefighters with essential gear, thermal cameras, and emergency response equipment.

### Long-term Recovery & Rebuilding:

**California Community Foundation**: Administers recovery support and rebuilding assistance programs for fire-affected communities.

**Habitat for Humanity**: Rebuilds homes for families who lost their houses in wildfires.
